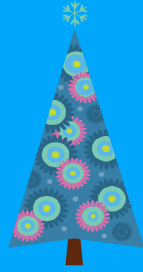

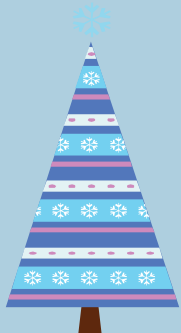

Kenny Bounds' Legacy Lives On

This is a short note with information below from one of our members Margaret Bounds. Many of you knew Kenny Bounds who lost his battle with cancer almost three years ago. See what Margaret has to say about what Kenny's legacy is leaving behind.

I just thought I would share with you our great news. As you know when we lost Kenny to colon cancer, we set up a foundation in his name for research. In January it will be 3 years since he lost his struggle with that terrible disease. Dr. Cathy Eng was Kenny's doctor at M.D. Anderson. She has been working with the funds provided to this research foundation. While this is just a small step we are thoroughly excited that some progress is being made. Our family would like to say thanks to all of you who have made this possible by means of donations directly to his research foundation and the Colon fun run (Kenny's Krew) we do every March. Dearest Mrs. Bounds,

I wanted to let you know we completed patient accrual to the phase III X-PECT Trial. Here is a press release: <http://www.biotechnologyevents.com/node/2795> re: early safety data from the Phase III study.

We are still collecting tumor specimens from the other sites. We were glad the trial enrolled so quickly. I wanted to let you know we are in the middle of the laboratory tumor analysis and continue to move ahead. The final clinical results of the study itself we hope will be available for to be presented at ASCO June 2012 in Chicago. Regarding the tumor specimens we hope the data should be ready by June 2013 for presentation. If the study is positive, the laboratory analysis of the tumor specimens will be critical towards determining which patient will or will not fare well from the use of Perifosine in metastatic colorectal cancer. My collaborator is Dr. Funda Meric-Bernstam and her lab has been an integral part of our progress.

I am currently conducting additional animal studies using this Perifosine as a radiation sensitizer for the treatment of rectal cancer. We are also working on cell lines and mouse models with Dr. Sunil Krishnan to see what colorectal cancer mutations may or may not impact chemotherapy combinations and which chemotherapy combinations will work well with Perifosine to make it even more effective. We are starting this work this month in the lab and have hired a lab assistant using your research funds.

Thank you for your generosity in assisting us in our research efforts for this new promising drug.

New GriefShare Session

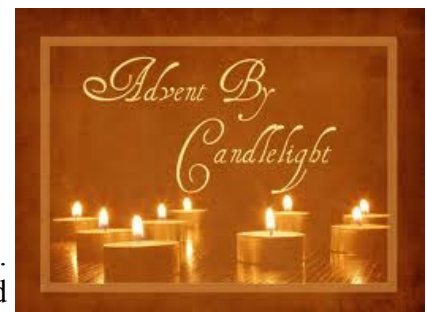

If you had \$25,000 to tap into to serve the community what would you do? Would you create a food pantry? Would you aide struggling addicts recover? Would you help families recuperate from disaster? Would you start a music school for underprivileged youth? Would you found a clinic? Imagine the possibilities!

Due to a generous gift by Thrivent Financial for Lutherans LINC Houston's Mission Churches have the opportunity to procure up to \$25,000 to resource community development initiatives like the ones described above, but **we need your help!**
