Annual Voters' Assembly Results

On December 11, our members gathered for our annual Voters' Assembly Meeting. This was the most positive meeting most of our leaders can remember! We had a large turnout of approximately 150 members, and excellent comments and feedback from our voters.

In the Board of Directors election, Steve Fritsche and Michael Lovelace were voted as our new At-Large Members and the slate of candidates of Dave Baden, Chairman and Margaret Reed, Treasurer was ratified by the voters.

The following action items were enthusiastically passed by our congregation:

(1) Extend a divine call to Caroline Gray to serve as our full-time Director of Children's Ministry, commencing January 1, 2012.

(2) Support Brad Jurischk's entry into The Specific Ministry Program at Concordia Seminary, St. Louis, MO. This 4 year program enables Brad to become a pastor within the Lutheran Church, Missouri Synod. Our congregation will fund Brad's education in the amount of \$8,000 per year. He will continue to serve as our Director of Student Ministry while securing his education, and will serve as a Pastor to St. Timothy for

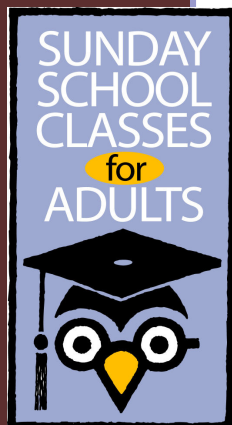
at least an additional 5 years after completion of the program.

(3) Support our building capital campaign, which we have named the "Expand HIS Kingdom" campaign. The congregation voted to expand the proposed new building from 2.6 to 3 million dollars, so that the entire upper floor of the 2-story building can be finished, adding 4 large adult classrooms. The congregation also voted to eliminate the language to put all dollars in excess of those needed for our new building and remodeling needs, into debt reduction. Any excess dollars will first be used to complete the entire second story of the new building, adding the four large classrooms, and then to reduce debt. It was agreed that St. Timothy will not incur any new long-term debt, but will build expansion space within the totality of pledges and monies received for this campaign. Since this is a general concept, and not a definite plan until the campaign is completed, another congregational voters meeting will be called directly after pledges are received, to present final building and expansion plans.

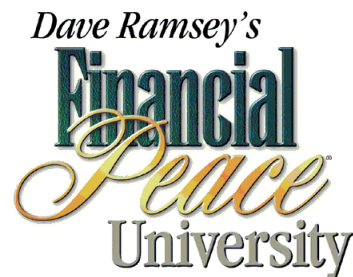
Financial Peace University

“Expand HIS Kingdom!”

Why did Jesus come at Christmas? He came “to bring the Kingdom of God into this world.” In fact, in the Lord's Prayer, Jesus teaches us to pray “Thy Kingdom Come.” (Matthew 6:10) How often have we said those words without even comprehending what Jesus meant? God's Kingdom sounds like something far away, but in fact, it is the saving grace and power of Jesus Christ at work in our lives as His disciples! When we pray “Thy Kingdom come” we first profess Him as our Savior and our King. As our King, we also pray for Him to rule and direct our lives each day. Jesus challenged us to “seek first the Kingdom and His righteousness.” (Matthew 6:33) Most importantly, Jesus taught us to pray for His Kingdom to grow and expand!

Our prayer is for Jesus to use us to “Expand HIS Kingdom” and His Spirit is helping us grow. Since 2007, our worship attendance is up 10%, Sunday School has expanded 30%, and Adult Education has grown 20%. Bright Beginners Pre-School and Infant Care has grown from 38 students to 78 and is out of classroom space. We need a music/education room and more classrooms for “growing disciples of all ages.” One obstacle to this growth is the shortage of classroom space and the advanced age of our present Annex. We have needed additional facilities for some time. A building plan in 2008 was delayed because of the stock market crash that year. Since then we've experienced even more growth and still face a shortage in classrooms for children, adults, and a music room for our music ministries.

For this reason, our congregation voted to begin a three year Building Fund Campaign titled “Expand HIS Kingdom!” The focus is not on a building, but to “Expand HIS Kingdom” by bringing the Gospel of Jesus Christ to our people and this community. The building is simply a place for us to teach and grow disciples. We want every child to learn about Jesus' love and be part of His Kingdom. We want every family to know Jesus and experience the blessing of His Kingdom. We want our own children and adults to grow strong in faith, love, and courage to live boldly for Christ. We want to equip our people of every age to “Expand HIS Kingdom” in our homes, schools, and workplaces in this community.

This three year campaign will provide new facilities and renovations to expand Christ's Kingdom and help us to accomplish three major goals:

1. New Education Building for Bright Beginners, Adult Education and Music - Approximate cost: \$2.9 – 3.0 million
 - a. Adult Education and Music Ministry - 6,203 square feet of space on the second floor with 6 adult classrooms, a music room, and furnishings. In addition, we will add parking and site work with drainage/retention.
 - b. New pre-school facility for our rapidly growing Bright Beginners Pre-School – 10,666 square feet of space with 9 classrooms, office, workroom, and storage.
2. Renovate our present facilities in three areas:

Renovation of Bright Beginners/Children's Building for multi-purpose use for children and adult ministries, new LED lighting in the Sanctuary, and a new Mondo Advance floor in the Life Center. These long needed improvements will improve our facilities for worship, Children's Ministry, and adult discipleship. Approximate Cost: \$260,000
3. Debt Reduction – Any excess revenue over the cost of the new facilities/renovations will go to reduce our long term debt. Reducing our debt allows us to invest into more missions and ministries to “Expand HIS Kingdom!”

GriefShare - Our Second Session Begins

A new GriefShare session begins on **January 12, 2012**. GriefShare is a Christ-centered 13-week program that helps you learn how to live with grief in a healthy manner. GriefShare is not a program that eliminates the grief, but rather helps you

learn how to live a new "normal." Each session stands on its own, so you can attend whenever it is convenient for you. The group will meet in the office conference room from 7-9 PM each Thursday.



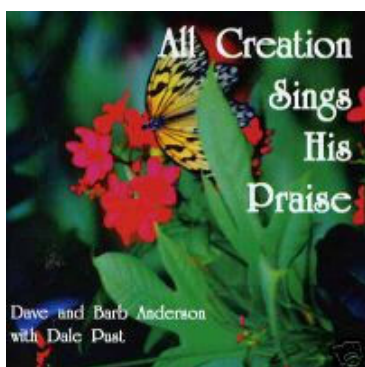
Zone 45 - AWESOMENESS CONTINUES

Since 1975 Fellowship Ministries' mission has been "to provide relevant worship resources, training, and encouragement for advancing the Gospel of Jesus Christ".

Fellowship Ministries began as an organization for Gospel concerts presented by husband and wife team, Dave and Barb Anderson. For 18 years, they presented concerts in 16 churches every month.

Since 1975 Dave and Barb Anderson have presented 5,000 concerts in America, Asia, Europe, Australia, New Zealand and the Middle East. Concert venues have included churches, conferences and conventions, elementary and high schools, universities, radio and TV programs, in Eskimo and Russian villages, on a floating hotel on the Saudi Arabian shore, "in secret" in Nepal, and in thatched-roof sanctuaries in Papua New Guinea.

They have produced over 20 uplifting albums. Barb is no longer singing with Dave but the concerts still uplift Jesus and spread the Gospel of Jesus.

Our Gifts Share Jesus' Love

"There is a God," said one little girl after she received a toy of her very own. Raised by her grandmother here in Houston along with her sister, she had very little in terms of possessions. In her bedroom there was one bed for each girl and a book case with two books. Her family was invited to come to LINC to pick out some toys and some clothes, which they did tentatively and with great joy. This little girl understood that all good things come from God, and expressed this simple article of faith when she received something precious. She taught that, through Jesus, the little things that we do can make a big impact in the life of a struggling family. Every Christmas season, God allows LINC to experience thousands of these

little God moments through the distribution of food, clothing and toys to families in need. Many families who are struggling because of the poor economy are left with few options when it comes to feeding their families and providing presents. Are all destitute? Probably not. However, when the bills are paid in these households, very few dollars are left, if any, for food and other essentials. Perhaps some will believe this for the very first time. As we venture into 2012, please remember the communities that are
